CHARTER SCHOOL REVOCATION

The Governing Board expects any charter school it authorizes to provide a sound educational program that promotes student learning and to carry out its operations in a manner that complies with law, the terms of its charter and any memoranda of understanding or other agreement(s) between the charter school and the district. The Board may revoke a charter in accordance with law.

The Board may revoke a charter before the date it is due to expire if it finds through a showing of substantial evidence, that the charter school has done any of the following: (Education Code 47607)

1. Committed a material violation of any of the conditions, standards, or procedures set forth in the charter
2. Failed to meet or pursue any of the outcomes identified in the charter

The Board shall also consider revoking the charter of any charter school for which the California Collaborative for Educational Excellence (CCEE), has provided advice and assistance pursuant to Education Code 47607.3, if CCEE has issued either of the following findings: (Education Code 47607.3)

1. That the charter school has failed or is unable to implement the ; or
2. That the inadequate performance of the charter school based on the California School Dashboard is so persistent or acute as to require revocation of the charter
