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Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Assembly Bill 329 California Healthy Youth Act requires that comprehensive sexual health educa on and human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) preven on educa on be taught to students at least once in middle school and once in high school, beginning no later than grade seven. Instruc on and materials must be medically accurate, objec ve, age-appropriate and inclusive of all students, as defined by law. The law requires that instruc on and materials must encourage students to communicate with parents, guardians, or other trusted adults about human sexuality.

Fontana Unified School District is using the Posi ve Preven on Plus Curriculum to meet these instruc onal requirements in grade 7 Science and Physical Educa on grade 9. The purpose of this instruc on is to:

- Provide students with the knowledge and skills necessary to protect their sexual and reproduc ve health from HIV and other sexually transmit ed infec ons and from unintended pregnancy.
- Provide students with the knowledge and skills they need to develop healthy a tudes concerning
 adolescent growth and development, body image, gender, sexual orienta on, rela onships, marriage, and
 family.
- Promote understanding of sexuality as a normal part of human development.
- Ensure students receive integrated, comprehensive, accurate, and unbiased sexual health and HIV preven on instruc on and provide educators with clear tools and guidance to accomplish that end.
