## ARTICLE 4

## **DISTRICT RIGHTS**

- 4.1 It is understood and agreed that the District retains all of its powers and authority to direct, manage, and control to the full extent of the law. Included in, but not limited to, those duties and powers are the right to:
- Determine its organization; direct the work of its employees; determine the times and hours of operation; determine the kinds and levels of services to be provided and the methods and means of providing them; establish its educational policies, goals, and object, or modify facilities; establish budge procedures and determine budgetary allocation; determine the methods of raising revenue; take action in the event of an emergency, i.e., act of God, natural disaster, act of war, declaration of martial law, strike, insurrection, revolution, flood, earthquake, fire, epidemic, plague, power failure, or energy crisis; hire, classify, assign, transfer, evaluate, promote, terminate, and discipline bargaining unit members.
