

Obituary - William "Bill" Paluzzi

William "Bill" Paluzzi, 65, a former resident of Fontana, passed away Friday, Feb. 8 at San Bernardino Community Hospital.

Bill was born in Dearborn, Michigan to Albert and Alma Paluzzi.
