

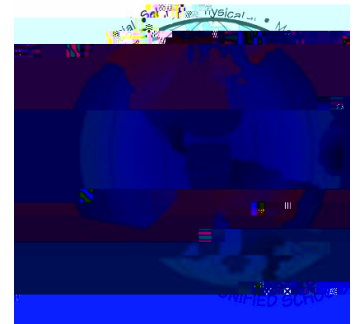

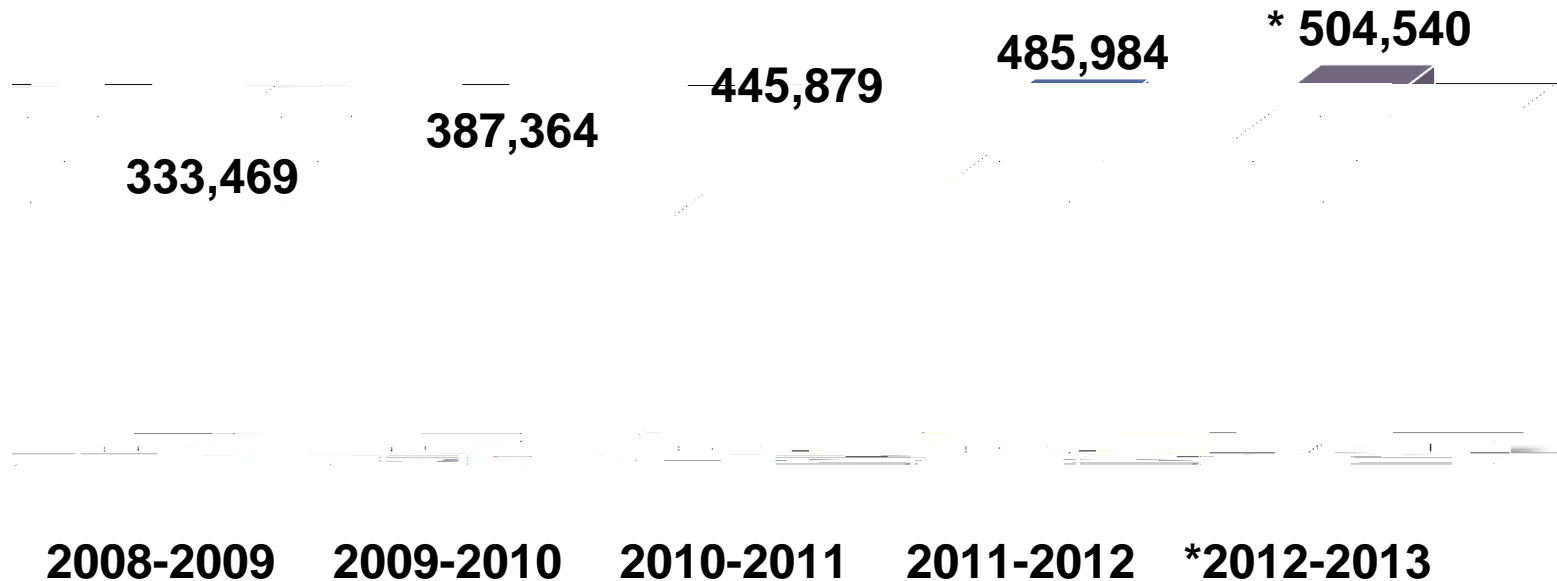
# After School Education and Safety (ASES)

- The After School Education and Safety (ASES) Program is the result of the 2002 voter-approved initiative, Proposition 49
- The intent of ASES is to provide safe and educationally enriching alternatives for children and youth during non-school hours through partnerships between schools and local

# Program Impact

- The Fontana After School Program in FUSD currently services up to 3,300 students daily at 28 Elementary School and 5 Middle School sites
- There are currently 552 students on waiting lists at two-thirds of the Fontana After School Program sites

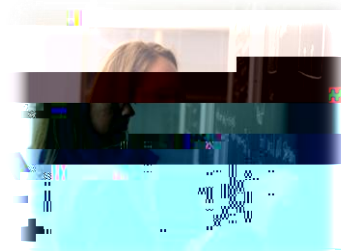

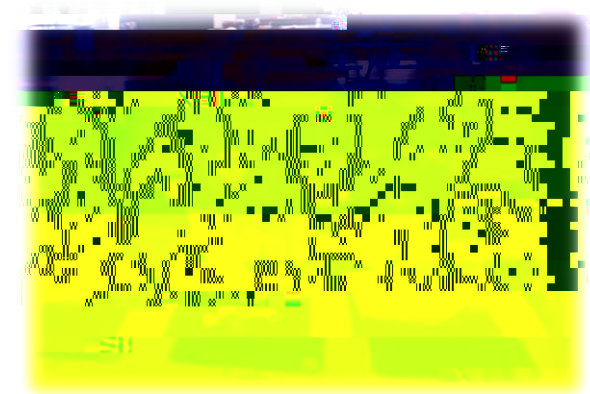

Provide continuous staff development

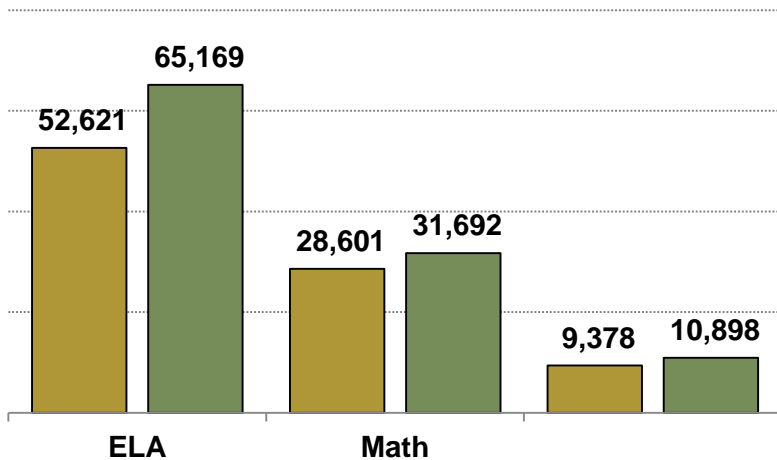

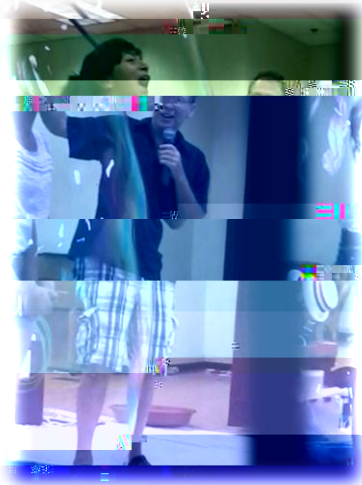
# Program Data
