





<u>After School Education and Safety (ASES)</u>

- The After School Education and Safety (ASES) Program is the result of the 2002 voter-approved initiative, Proposition 49
- The intent of ASES is to provide safe and educationally enriching alternatives for children and youth during nonschool hours through partnerships between schools and local



- The Fontana After School Program in FUSD currently services up to 3,300 students daily at 28 Elementary School and 5 Middle School sites
- There are currently 552 students on waiting lists at two-thirds of the Fontana After School Program sites



Master Calendar


- The master calendar was created with the intent to increase communication amongst FUSD, Boys and Girls Club of Fontana, and the City of Fontana


